

#### Working Together for Children

Since 1997 the Lee County Sheriff's Office has been spotlighting students who make healthy decisions and positive choices, and who volunteer in our community. The goal of Do The Right Thing is to reinforce positive values and choices among students in grades K-12 and to encourage good citizenship and community involvement. The Sheriff's Office partners with the business and civic community to honor positive endeavors of our youth through monthly ceremonies and other special projects.

## We Recognize and Reward

Each month during the school year, nominations are submitted by parents, teachers, deputies and community leaders. Nominations may be for any positive act, such as volunteering, standing up to peer pressure or simply dedicating themselves to their schoolwork. In addition to monthly ceremonies, large groups of students may be honored through the Class of the Month Project and some winners are honored at a regional awards celebration held each summer.

## Spotlighting Young Role Models

Each month a board selects 10 students to honor publicly at an awards ceremony. Winners are spotlighted in the community as future leaders and role models for younger students.
