ON EARNING THE PRIVILEGE TO REPRESENT CALOOSA MIDDLE SCHOOL ATHLETICS. ALL STUDENT-ATHLETES AND THEIR PARENTS ARE REQUIRED TO READ, SIGN, AND RETURN THE BOTTOM PORTION OF THIS STUDENT-ATHLETE CONTRACT IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PLAY.

<u>GOALS, OBJECTIVES, AND GUIDELINES</u>

ACADEMICS

- Student comes before Athlete in the expression "STUDENT-ATHLETE".
- Practice and playing time can/will be limited if a student-athlete is performing poorly in any school subject.
- Failing ANY school subject is not acceptable. If a student-athlete has a failing grade (F) on their report card for any class, they will not be permitted to participate in games or practice with the team.

ATTITUDE & SPORTSMANSHIP

- Student-athletes are representing Caloosa Middle School, their families, and themselves. While competing, each student-athlete shall carry themselves with a positive attitude and good sportsmanship.
- Student-athletes are not permitted to speak to referees unless asked by the official or the coach.
- Student-athletes should never use profanity or taunt members of the opposing team.

BUS & SCHOOL EXPECTATIONS

- Student-athletes are expected to be positive members of the school community (i.e. in classrooms, hallways, the cafeteria, on the bus, etc.)
- Disruption of any school related environment will not be tolerated.
- Student-athletes who are sent out of class or who receive a discipline referral will apologize verbally or in a written letter to the instructor/driver and participate in supervised discipline for 1 practice. Student-athletes who are sent out of class on multiple occasions or receive multiple discipline referrals will meet with coaches and administration for possible dismissal from the team. • We maintain a **ZERO tolerance** policy on fighting, bullying, and demonstrating disrespect towards teachers/staff members. • Upon review, these actions will result in immediate dismissal from the team.
- Student-athletes who conduct poor sportsmanship will be subject to discipline from the coach at the following practice, including up to dismissal/removal from the team.

PARENT INVOLVEMENT

- Parents are required to stay away from the team's bench, locker room, studentathletes themselves, as well as coaches and officials, during gameplay. *the only exception is if your child is injured*
- Parents will refrain from shouting/yelling/directing student-athletes from the sidelines during practice and/or gameplay.
- If a parent has any questions, please schedule a time to meet with the coach(es) that does not interfere with practices or game time.
- Coaches will return emails and phone calls as soon as possible.

PLAYER DEVELOPMENT

- Student-athletes are expected to have a positive attitude at practices, training, and games in order to facilitate personal growth.
- Student-athletes should take every practice or training session seriously in order to be efficient and avoid wasting time.
- Coaches will provide the student-athlete with assistance in growing their personal skill level, their ability to work with a team, and assistance in preparing them for play at the high-school level.

PRACTICES

- Practices will be held on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays from 4:15 5:20 p.m. unless otherwise noted from the coaches.
- All student-athletes are expected to wear appropriate clothing to each practice and game, including bringing a water bottle to stay hydrated.

ROLE RESPONSIBILITY

- Student-athletes will put the team before themselves.
- Coaches will decide varsity and junior varsity teams when applicable.
- Playing time is determined by team needs, attitude, and effort at practices.
- NO PLAYER IS GUARANTEED PLAYING TIME. This is up to the coaches discretion.

UNEXCUSED ABSENCES

- Missing practice may result in limited or no playing time.
- <u>Ist offense</u>: student-athlete owes an apology to their team and 1 practice of supervised discipline (ex: running laps).
- <u>2nd offense</u>: student-athlete will be benched for 1 game or be removed from the team.
- Detentions/suspensions count as unexcused absences.



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
